


Singapore

Singapore is an island country that comprises of one main island, 63 satellite islands and islets, and 1 outlying islet. Most of us are familiar with the main island, where most of our daily activities are. Other than the well-known islands like Sentosa and Pulau Ubin, how much do we know about the other offshore islands? Let us find out more!



Many of the offshore islands are a boat ride away while some are just a walk away!
For instance, Sentosa and Coney Island are accessible via a bridge.









Pulau Hantu translates to "Island of Ghosts". It is made up of Pulau Hantu Kechil (Little Ghost Island) and Pulau Hantu Besar (Big Ghost Island). The name of the picturesque island may be due to the middle part of the island "disappearing" during high tide. And there is a legend of Malay warriors dueled to death and their ghosts wander on the island. Today, the peaceful island has sheltered beaches, swimming lagoons and corals around. Attracting fishing, scuba diving and snorkelling enthusiasts chartering boats to the island, as no ferry service is available. With permit, you can camp on the island to experience the wild.

Pulau Satumu is the southern most island of Singapore. Its name means "One Tree" in Malay. It is a very small island where one of Singapore's oldest lighthouses, Raffles Lighthouse, is located. Raffles Lighthouse is still in use today but is out-of-bound except for staff and visitors with special permission. The Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore conducts regular tours to the island and Raffles Lighthouse.



St. John's Island is located off the southern coast of Singapore, it was a quarantine centre in the 19th century. And in the 20th century, it served as a detention centre, drug rehabilitation centre and temporary refugee settlement. The west coast of St. John's Island is part of the Marine Park Islands, a marine protected area by government. Currently, it houses a few aquaculture research and development facilities.

Skip the cat cafes and visit St. John's Island to cat-watch as friendly cats can be seen lounging around. Bicycle rental is available, for the ease of exploring the island. It has a lagoons and beaches where you can go for a swim while having a picnic. With the clear water, you can find good spots for fishing. If you would like to stay the night on the island, you can rent a chalet or camp with a permit!

Lazarus Island is connected to St. John's Island by a causeway and does not have a ferry terminal. Visitors will need to alight the ferry at St. John's Island and take a short walk. In 1800s, there were prison confinement sheds on the island and were proved ineffective as a prisoner had successfully escaped. Today the island is known for having one of the best beaches in Singapore with its clear turquoise water and white sandy beach.

Tips for visiting offshore islands:

- · Check weather forecast.
- Check on ferry timings (if applicable).
- Find out amenties and facilities available on island and plan essentials that you will need to bring.
 For instance, you may need to pack food, drinks, sunscreen and insect repellent.



Sisters' Island are also part of the Marine Park Islands. One of the legends says that an elder sister tried to save the younger sister who was drowning. In the end, both sisters drowned. Touched by their love for one another, God turned them into two little islands so that they can be together forever.

The Big Sister Island is closed for enhancement works till 2024. Upon re-opening, the island will feature a coastal forest trail that leads to a hilltop viewing deck, also a birdwatching vantage point. And a tidal pool with educational and monitoring programmes for visitors. The Small Sister Island is not open to public as it is strictly for conservation and research.

With this information, start planning for a short escapade from the city without your passport and start island-hopping!




