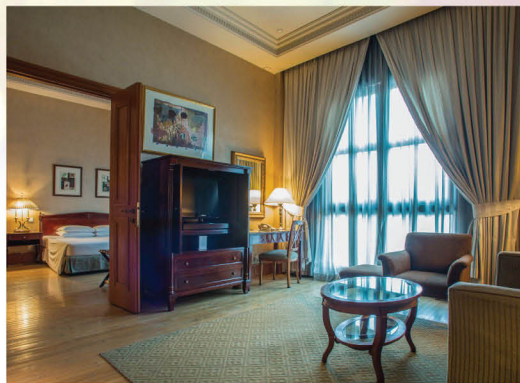

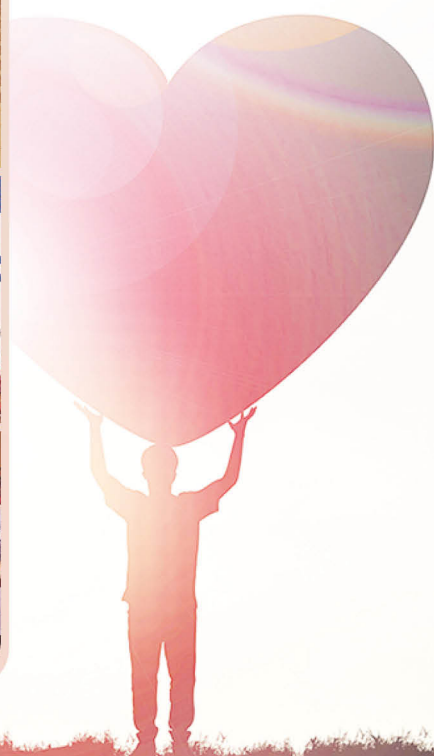

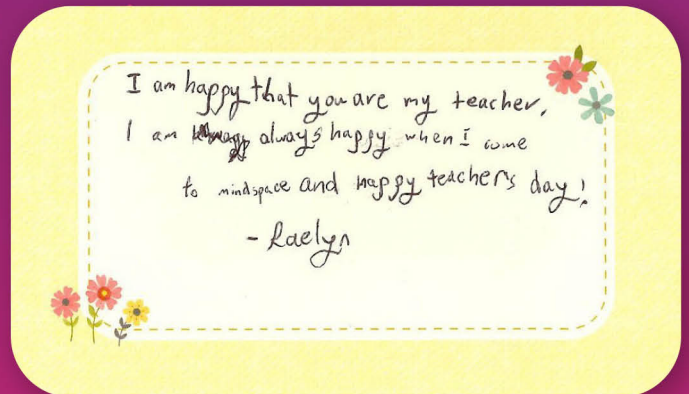

a Fresh New Year

With the Chinese New Year around the corner, it is about time to perform the annual “ritual” to deep clean the house, also known as spring cleaning! Here are some guidelines and tips to spring cleaning:

Start with a plan

Just the thought of deep cleaning the whole house may feel overwhelming. Plan your spring cleaning by individual room. Make a schedule and plan for the time needed. Having a checklist of the tasks will be helpful too. Prioritise frequently used rooms to be cleaned first. For each room, break up the tasks in such a way that can be completed within a block of time that works for you. For instance, completing a few tasks within 30 minutes a day, over several days.

Decluttering

Very often, clutter takes over the spaces in your home due to the increased in the number of things you own. Declutter by going through the items in the room. If an item has not been used in the past six months, it may be time to give it up. Sort unwanted items into categories: to throw, to recycle or to donate.

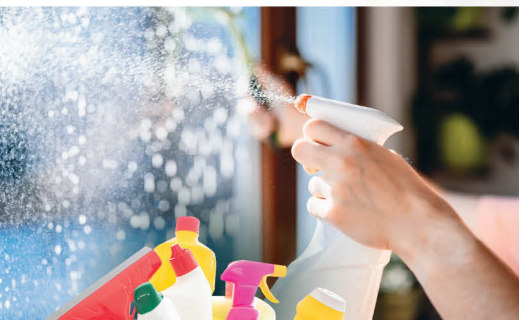
When decluttering, remember to look out and throw away expired items, especially in the kitchen. After removing unwanted and excess items, take the chance to reorganise the items you are keeping. You can designate areas and set up systems to keep things organised. For instance, set up baskets for received mails or put dividers in cupboard drawers to keep socks organised.

Tip: A monthly or quarterly deep cleaning schedule helps keep the house neat and clean, making the annual spring cleaning less daunting.

Top-to-bottom Cleaning

After decluttering, the next step is to gather your cleaning gears so that you can start dusting and cleaning the room from the top to the bottom. Start cleaning high-up fixtures, like lights, ceiling fans and the top of a cupboard, so that dust will not land on an already cleaned floor. This approach makes your cleaning workflow more efficient. After cleaning the high-up fixtures, you can move on to windows, walls then the furniture or cupboards. Remember to sanitise light switches and door knobs. Lastly, clean the floor!

Tip: Clean the ceiling fan with a pillowcase! Slide a fan blade into the pillowcase, gently close the opening of the pillowcase and remove the pillowcase keeping the dust inside. Shake off the dust and repeat for other blades. Wipe the blades clean with a damp microfibre cloth before wiping it dry with a dry cloth!



Eco-friendly cleaning

Consider skipping chemical cleaning products and going for eco-friendly ones, as they are safer for your family and is better for the environment too! You can try cleaning with natural ingredients like vinegar, baking soda and lemon juice.

Tip:

Remove Coffee Mug Stain

Fill the mug with one part baking soda and two parts water and soak for at least two hours. Next, making use of the gentle abrasive properties of baking soda, rub the mug with a sponge and rinse it clean.

Steam Clean Microwave Oven

Put lemon slices and hot water in a microwave-proof bowl, heat it up with beverage setting and let the steam sit in the microwave oven for a while, making it easier to remove stains on the oven's wall. The steam will soften dried food bits, while the lemon's acid helps break them down. The final step is to wipe clean the interior of the oven with a sponge.

Clean Cutting Board Stain

Get rid of stains on cutting board by sprinkling some salt or baking soda on the stain, then rub the cut side of a cut half lemon on the stain and rinse it clean.

Spring cleaning is more efficient and fun when family members are involved. They can help by spring cleaning their own room. And you will need an extra pair of hands to help move furnishings around.

It is important to remind yourself not to get stress over how perfect your spring cleaning was done, instead look at the result of achieving a healthier and more comfortable living space. With all the tips on hand, it is time to embark on your spring cleaning!
